## Stage

Width 5,50m (+ 2m backstage)

Depth 7m Height: 4,5m

Black or dark floor, black curtains, black back drop

The company brings white mat (5,50m x 6m) and 1 white net.

## Sound

2 speakers (L/R) for audience 2 stage monitors (L/R backstage)

1 mixer with stereo OUT and 2 AUX
The company brings 1 laptop and 1 stereo

sound card (2 OUT jack 6.35mm).
